About Organisation

The Sydney Symphony Orchestra is Australia's largest orchestra and performs up to 150 concerts a year.

The Sydney Symphony has 89 musicians who work full time.

The orchestra is led by their Chief Conductor, Simone Young.

Many of the Sydney Symphony's concerts are performed in the Concert Hall at the Sydney Opera House, but sometimes they perform in other venues like Sydney Town Hall where the Relaxed Classics with the Sydney Symphony concert will be.

The front door is **up the steps**.

If I need to use the accessible entrance I can enter via **Druitt St** (opposite the Queen Victoria Building).

I can use the lift at this entrance.

Accessibility features

Wheelchair access

If I use a wheelchair or need step-free access, I can enter the building through the Druitt Street entrance (opposite the Queen Victoria Building). There is a lift at this entrance.

Wheelchair/mobility parking

For parking, there are 3 wheelchair/mobility parking spaces nearby: 93 Bathurst Street (1 parking space).252 Pitt Street (2 parking spaces).

I can also park at the Wilson Car Park at St Andrews House, 464 Kent Street. I can book my parking online at bookabay.wilsonparking.com.au.

Accessibility features

Accessible Toilets



Ground Floor – There are accessible toilets in the North Corridor (Druitt Street side) near the stage.

1st Floor Gallery – There are accessible toilets in the Northern and Southern corridors near the stage.



Hearing Loop

If I use a hearing aid, I can use the wireless hearing loop available in the venue.



Familiarisation tour

I can also ask for a familiarization tour. This is a tactile or familiarization tour to help me feel more comfortable in the building.



Assistance animals

If I have a guide dog or assistance animal, I can bring them with me. I will need to email the Sydney Symphony at info@sydneysymphony.com before I arrive. This way, they can help make any special arrangements if needed.

Rules / Expected Behaviours



When I arrive, an usher will check my ticket.



I can move around the space, but I will not touch any instruments.



I can clap, but only after each piece of music has finished.



I can wear clothes that make me feel comfortable.

I will try to talk quietly. This is so I don't disrupt the performance



When I am in the venue I can only consume food and drink (excluding water) that I have bought at the Sydney Town Hall.





During my visit to Sydney Town Hall, I might have different sensory experiences.

These could include:



Bright lights



Dark areas



Crowding



Unexpected touch



Sounds like clapping, announcements, instrument tuning.

What to bring/What not to bring

Sometimes it is busy, noisy, bright and loud at a Sydney Symphony Orchestra Concert.

I can bring things to help me enjoy the day.

Things I might want to bring include:













Sunglasses and Hat

Headphones

Water bottle

Sensory tools



Food and Drink

I can buy food and drinks in the Vestibule of Sydney Town Hall (STH).

The Vestibule is the entrance area inside the Town Hall.

I can only pay with a bank card or credit card.

I can eat or drink the food I buy from the STH Vestibule during the concert.

I cannot bring or eat food or drinks (excluding water) from outside the STH inside the venue.

If I want to eat or drink before or after the concert, I can go to places nearby:

- Woolworths on George Street (across from the STH).
- The Galleries Food Court (access from George Street).
- World Square Food Court (access from George Street).

Booking tickets/Pricing

Tickets cost **\$25.00** each.

I can buy tickets on the Sydney Symphony website on the Relaxed Concerts page:

If I buy a full-price ticket, I can bring 1 support person with me for free.

This could be someone with a Companion Card or someone I choose to support me.

Refunds:

If I can't come to the concert, I can get a full refund.

I can call the Sydney Symphony Box Office at **8215 4600** or email <u>info@sydneysymphony.com</u> to cancel my booking.

The Box Office is open Monday to Friday, 9:00 am – 4:00 pm.

If I need to cancel on the day of the concert, I can email info@sydneysymphony.com.

A staff member might ask why I need a refund, but it's only to help me.

Real Planning my journey



Train: I can take a train directly to Sydney Town Hall. It stops at Town Hall Station on George Street.



Bus: I can take a bus to Park Street, which is a 5-minute walk from the venue.



Light Rail: The light rail station is called **Town Hall Station**, and it's right outside the venue on **George Street**.



Ferry: The nearest ferry stops at **Darling Harbour Wharf**, which is a **15-minute** walk from the venue.



Taxi: The closest taxi rank is at **Pitt Street** and **Castlereagh Street**, about a **5-minute** walk away.



Metro: I can also take the metro to Gadigal Station, which is a 5-minute walk from the venue.







Bike: I can park my bike at the facilities available on both the **Druitt St forecourt** and the **Sydney Square** side of the building.

Parking: I can park at the **Wilson Parking car park at 464 Kent Street**. I need to **pre-book** my parking at **bookabay.wilsonparking.com.au**.

Public Transport: For more information about public transport, I can call **131 500** or visit <u>transportnsw.info</u>

Arriving

I will arrive at the main Sydney Town Hall door on **George Street**.

If I need to pick up my concert ticket, I can collect it from the Box Office.

The Box Office entrance is at the top of the stairs to the left-hand side.

If I already have my ticket, I can go to the top of the stairs and an usher will check my ticket.

I will give the Customer Service Representative my order number or my full name and they will give me my ticket.

After I walk through the foyer, I will enter **The Vestibule**. This is a big room in front of the Centennial Hall, where the performance will be. An usher will look at my ticket at the doorway to Centennial Hall to see where I am seated.

When the performance starts, there will be an announcement to welcome the audience and remind people to **turn off their mobile phones**.

Then, the conductor, **Benjamin Northey**, who conducts the orchestra, will walk onstage. People will start clapping to welcome him.

Where are toilets/accessible toilets located?

Accessible unisex toilets are available on each publicly accessible floor of the building.

Where can I get help?

The ushers on the side of the hall will be happy to help me with any questions.

Where can I go if I feel overwhelmed or need somewhere quiet?

The Vestibule, which is outside the hall, is quieter than the Centennial Hall. I can also step outside if I need a break.

How will I find out about any disruptions or changes?

The Sydney Symphony Orchestra will contact me by **email or text** if there are any changes to the performance.

Who should I contact for more information?

The performance will end at about 11:00am.

To exit the venue, I can head towards the **back of the hall** or use a nearby exit where the ushers will open the doors.

If I prefer, I can wait in my seat until the crowd has gone down, or I can leave quickly when the performance ends to avoid queues.

Once I have picked up any items from the cloakroom, I can exit through the main entrance.

There are lots of public transport options nearby, including light rail, train, metro, and bus.
